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RESOLUTION

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FROM DENNIS FRIENDS FOUNDATION AND PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE ANIMAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT IN FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027.

WHEREAS, the Dennis Friends Foundation wishes to grant the City of Albuquerque \$100,000 to purchase veterinary equipment for the Westside Shelter Veterinary Clinic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque Animal Welfare Department will utilize the grant funds to purchase veterinary equipment that will be used in the Westside Shelter/Community Veterinary Clinic; and

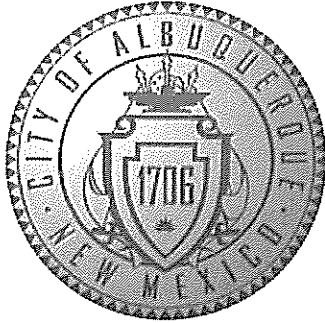
WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque Animal Welfare Department desires to accept these funds, which require no City match or indirect overhead to support the purchase of the equipment.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

Section 1. That the attached application for Dennis Friends Foundation for the amount of \$100,000, and its acceptance and filing with the appropriate official or office is and in all respects approved.

Section 2. That upon approval, funds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000) are hereby appropriated to the Animal Welfare Department to purchase equipment for the Westside Shelter/Community Veterinary Clinic in the Operating Grant Fund 265 for Fiscal Year 2026/2027.

Cover Analysis

- 1. What is it?** Resolution approving and accepting the FY/27 Dennis Friends Foundation Veterinary Equipment Grant
- 2. What will this piece of legislation do?** This legislation approves an application to utilize this grant to purchase veterinary equipment for the Westside Shelter/Community Veterinary Clinic.
- 3. Why is this project needed?** There is a need for preventative veterinary care for pets (spay/neuter, vaccinations) on the Westside of Albuquerque. This grant will help purchase equipment for the new Clinic at the Westside Animal Shelter.
- 4. How much will it cost and what is the funding source?** The grant from Dennis Friends Foundation is for \$100,000 and does not require a cash match or indirect cost.
- 5. Is there a revenue source associated with this contract? If so, what level of income is projected?** Grant of \$100,000 from Dennis Friends Foundation will be appropriated to fund 265.
- 6. What will happen if the project is not approved?** The City will have to cover all the cost of equipment.
