2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS

3 FROM THE NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARKS ASSOCIATION IN

4 PARTNERSHIP WITH NIKE AND U.S. OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC

5 COMMITTEE ON “HOW TO COACH KIDS AND HOW TO COACH GIRLS,” AND

6 APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AND FAMILY

8 WHEREAS, the Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division

9 of the Department of Youth and Family Services will benefit from this funding

10 appropriated in order to train 60 staff in how to coach kids and how to coach

11 girls; and

12 WHEREAS, the Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division

13 applied for and was awarded these funds based on current sports

14 programming within the Division; and

15 WHEREAS, the Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division

16 will use these funds to boost the level of professionalism within the City of

17 Albuquerque’s community center programs to include, but not limited to

18 basketball, flag football, volleyball, and soccer; and

19 WHEREAS, the grant funding, as awarded, would be provided in one lump

20 sum in the amount of \$2,500 to the City to be spent from the Department of

21 Youth and Family Services, and no matching funds are required.

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF

23 ALBUQUERQUE:

24 Section 1. That Council hereby approves and authorizes the City of

25 Albuquerque’s Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division to

26 accept the grant appropriated under the NRPA in the amount of \$2,500, and its

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1 acceptance and filing with appropriate official or office is in all respects
2 approved.

3 Section 2. That the funds in the amount of \$2,500 from the NRPA are
4 hereby appropriated to the Department of Youth and Family Services in the
5 Operating Grants Fund (265).

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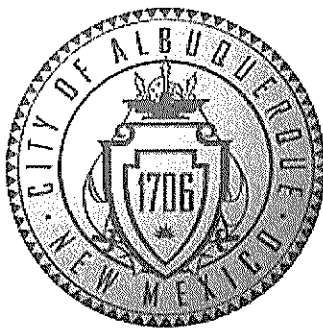

The Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division (CREI) has been awarded a grant through the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA). As a result of this grant, CREI will strive to train 60 staff, coaches and volunteers working with youth through Nike in partnership with the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC)'s How To Coach Kids and How To Coach Girls.

CREI will receive online, self-paced training through Nike in partnership with the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC)'s How To Coach Kids and How To Coach Girls, as well as up to 60 complimentary seats for Nike in partnership with the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC)'s How To Coach Kids and How To Coach Girls's online, self-paced modules. NRPA will collaborate with City of Albuquerque to encourage participation in training.

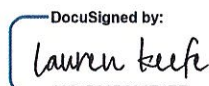
CREI will provide regular updates on the number of staff, coaches and volunteers trained through the training. CREI will ensure all training is completed by July 31, 2026.
